The Treasurer reported a balance of \$201.45 on hand May 26, 1917.

Miss Walcott for the Book committee reported the purchase of 114 volumes with State fund. of \$148.40 \$13.19 of Town funds were also used in the purchase of books, and for popular magazines there was an expenditure of \$25.50
