May 15, At an adjourned meeting of the Greeneville  
Public Library held at the Town Clerk's Office  
in Greeneville, on Monday evening May 15, 1882  
present M. Morrow, Martin Mann,  
Daniel F. Chandler, Thad. Vaughan, Orin  
A. Aygell, Ida Steese, Fannie Steese, Mattie  
M. Jones, O. D. Patch and Oscar A. Doty;

The Committee appointed at the previous  
meeting to draft Constitution and by-  
laws presented a report and the report  
was accepted;

After some discussion of the question and  
some slight amendments of the draft as  
reported by the committee a Constitution  
and by laws were adopted as follows:

### Constitution,

Article I. Name and Object,

Section 1. The name of this Association  
shall be the Greeneville Public Library,

Sec. 2. The Object of this Association shall  
be to provide a library and reading room  
and to promote literary and social  
intercourse among its members.

### Article II. Members,

Section 1. Any person above the age of  
fourteen years may become and there-  
after continue, a member by paying  
one dollar annually,

Sec. 2. Any person above the age of  
fourteen years may become a life  
member by the payment of twenty  
dollars at any one time,

### Article III. Officers,

Section 1. The officers of this Association  
shall consist of a President, three Vice  
Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer, five  
Trustees, a Librarian and an Assistant  
Librarian,
