property of the Association; shall make all requisite rules and regulations for its management; and shall make report of their action, and of the state of the association at the annual meeting;

Article 2, The Board of Directors may appoint special committees on any subject connected with the interests of the association, and shall annually appoint the Librarian and Assistant Librarian,

Article 3, It shall be the duty of the president, and in his absence of one of the vice presidents, to preside at all meetings of the association and of the Board of Directors, and to enforce and observe the rules established by parliamentary usage,

Article 4, The Secretary shall notify all officers and committees of their election, and keep a fair and correct record of the transactions of the Association and of the Board of Directors,

Article 5, The Treasurer shall receive all moneys due the association disburse the same under the direction of the Board of Directors, keep a full account of his receipts and expenditures and report the same to the Board of when so required, and to the association at the annual meeting,

Article 6, The Librarian and Assistant Librarian shall have custody of all the books, pamphlets, documents and other movable property of the Association pertaining to the Library and Reading Room; and shall keep such records as the Board of Directors may require,

Article 7, The use of the library shall be free to all residents of the town
