At a special meeting of the Board of Directors, held at the Town Clerks Office, on Monday July 17, 1882 present Rev. W. S. May Jr., D. B. Chandler, Henry S. Lathrop, John P. Gardner and Oscar A. Tobey:

Voted that the system styled the "Card system" for drawing books from the Library be and hereby is adopted.

A form for Card Register, for cards, &c was adopted, and the Secretary was duly authorized to procure all the necessary Blank Books, printing &c to carry the system into operation.
