Associated Regulations,

1. No Book shall be kept from the Library more than fourteen days,
2. Books overdue incur a fine of two cents each day, and costs of recovery,
3. No person may have more than one book out at a time,
4. Any book lost or damaged must be paid for by the person to whom such book is charged on the Librarian's record, "
