A meeting of the Board of Directors, held at the Library, on the 18th day of September 1882 present W. I. Magill, H. Latham, J. F. Gardner, D. F. Chandler, Ora A. Angell and Oscar A. Tobey.

Voted that the Treasurer of this Library be and he is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of this library, a lease of the building in the village of Greenville, owned by Nicholas S. Minson, and fitted up by him for the use of this library, for a term not exceeding five years from Sept 1, 1882, upon such terms as have been heretofore agreed upon with said Nicholas S. Minson by a committee of the board of directors of this library.

Voted that the library shall be kept open on Wednesday of each week from 6.30 P.M. to 9 P.M.; and on Saturday of each week from 4 P.M. to 9 P.M.

Voted that Henry S. Latham be a committee to purchase books for the library to the extent of \$30, one half of said sum to be expended in Juvenile Books.

Voted that Rev W. I. Magill, D. F. Chandler and J. F. Gardner be a committee to secure if possible the books in the library at Hammon R. I., for use in Greenville Public Library.

Voted that O. A. Tobey be a committee to apply to Mr. Thos. Minson for the books in Latham Institute for the benefit of this library.
