

Feb 20 '32 The regular quarterly meeting of the Greenville Library Association was held at the library. The last meeting was reported by the secretary, and report was approved. The Treasurer's statement showed total receipts since May 16, 1931 - \$244.95. With balance on hand at beginning of year \$13.22 the total amount was \$457.97. Of this amount \$63.- was received for membership dues.

After bills had been paid for lights, books, fuel, magazines, librarians, and state tax a balance remained of \$121.80. This statement was received.

It was voted to send a note to Mr. Richard Clarence expressing the fact that he was missed from the meeting, that the members wished him to know that they appreciated the helpfulness he had in many ways shown to the library, with the hope that he might soon be able to join again in their deliberations. Adjournment followed.
