

May 21-1932 - Annual Meeting of Greenville Public Library Association,
Rev. G. A. Burgess, presiding.

The Secretary's report of Feb. meeting was approved.

Report of Treasurer showed total receipts \$664.72; expenditures \$477.42,
leaving a balance of \$187.30. This report was approved.

Report of Book Committee showed \$189.25 spent received from state,
\$2.64 spent from town money for books. Several gifts were reported,
in addition to those donated by Prof. Hastings, there were books
received from the Chandler family, also from President of the
Association.

The Librarian reported number using the library 315 persons. Of these
46 were new patrons. There were 39 children using the library. This
report was accepted with appreciation expressed for faithful
service of the Librarian.

It was voted to renew present insurance policies. The treasurer
being authorized to pay if necessary from the accrued interest of
the bank account of \$1325.26.

It was voted to give the Librarian an additional week for
preparation to reopen library June 1.
