May 15, 1935 The Annual Meeting of the Greenville Public Library Association was held Saturday evening, May 18, 1935 in the Library, President E. A. Burgess presiding. The Secretary's report was read and approved. The Treasurer's report, audited by Mrs. Clemence and showing a balance of \$1.75, was accepted. The report of the book committee was received and read and placed on file. The committee reported 50 volumes of non-fiction and 42 volumes of fiction purchased during the year at a cost of \$186.62, of which \$187.64 was received from the State of Rhode Island. The Librarian's report was accepted - number of books in Library 8572 - number of books circulated 4950 - number of patrons 387.
