

May 16, 1936 The Annual Meeting of the Greenwich Public Library Association was held Saturday evening, May 16, 1936 in the library, President G.A. Burgess presiding. The Secretary's report was read and approved. The Treasurer's report, audited by Mr. Chenevise, and showing a balance of \$6.05, was accepted. The report of the book committee was received, indicating that 44 volumes of fiction and 56 volumes of non-fiction were purchased during the year at a cost of \$164.32 from funds received from the State of Rhode Island.
