The Annual meeting of the Greenville Public Library Association was held May 20, 1950 in the library building. President Chas. A. Steere in the Chair. Members present 12. Secretary read the record of last meeting.

Annual reports presented and accepted as follows.
Treasurers report - Receipts \$437.17 Expenses \$351.85
Bal. \$85.32. Savings acct. #2856 - \$16,447.87. Act #880
\$2614.81.

Book Comm. report - State appropriation \$177. Total books received 89. Book Comm. Chairmans request for a key to the library was granted.

Collector reported 500 letters sent. Received \$146.⁰⁰ from 132 members.

Librarian reported 1642 vols. circulated. 116 vols. added. 10,340 Vols. at end of year. 30 new patrons.

Miss Burlingame reported that Mr. Thomas still says he is going to do the repairs.

On request of Chairman of Book Comm. Voted that not more than \$50.⁰⁰ be allowed Book Comm. for the purpose of rebinding essential books.

A letter from Chas. H. White, realtor, was read stating, no sale for Jenckes house.

The Comm. appointed to interview the contractor for a recheck on figures to ^{the} the Jenckes house reported that 10% be added to previous figures.

Mr. A. B. Winsor reported interviewing Judge Geo. E. Thurber in regards to the will of H. F. Jenckes. Letter in Secretary's files.
