Book Committee Chairman reported Mr. & Mrs. Kay Moore are helping to catalogue the library. Mr. Moore is Head Cataloger in the John Hay Library, Providence. A number of requests were presented by Mrs. H. Jones.

Mr. Fernald said Mr. Jonak, Librarian of Brown University Library, had been looking over the books for valuable books.

To make the library more cheerful and attractive it was voted, that all lights be kept on during Library hours.

Voted. that all mail for the Book Comm. be addressed "Chairman of Book Committee of Greenville Public Library."
