The Greenville Public Library Association meeting was held Nov. 25, 1950 at 8 P.M. in the Library Building. 10 members present. President A. B. Mercer presiding.

Minutes of Aug. 19th meeting read and approved.

The Book Committee Chairman reported disposition of books to the R.I. Medical Society Library, Brown University Library, R.I. State Library, "Our Lady of Refuge" and 4 tons sold, also some of the Gross household articles stored in Library attic had been taken by a relative.

Mr. Moore reported 1200 books of fiction catalogued, 121 new books.

Voted that the Book Committee's Mr. Moore's report be accepted with thanks.

Treasurer reported the sale of 4 tons of books at a gross of \$73.32 and net of \$63.32. Balance in Treasury \$111.59.

On motion of Mr. Tynng it was Voted that the Board of Directors use available money to improve the Library rooms.

On motion of Mr. Fernald, seconded by Mr. Tynng it was voted that this Association call to the attention of the Board of Directors the desirability of investing the Jenckes Memorial Building Fund to better advantage.
