

Feb. 17, 1951

The regular Quarterly meeting of the Greenville Public Library Association was held Feb. 17, 1951 at 8 P.M. in the Library building. President Arthur B. Mercer in the Chair. 17 members present. Records of Nov. 25th & Dec. 9th were read.

Mr. E. H. Fernald gave a report of interview with Mr. E. C. Pickerson of Greenville Trust Co. concerning investments listed "A" & "B".

Mr. G. B. Kinsor reported interviewing Mr. Ernest S. Hopkins on moving the Jenckes house. Mr. Hopkins was willing to meet with Committee.

Voted that the Committee be empowered to sign the contract for the moving of Jenckes house.

Mr. Stephen Steere, Committee on repairs, reported interviewing Harry Turner, who gave an estimate of \$175.00 for repairs to Library building. An estimate of \$215.00 for 2 coats of paint by Jenckes Smith.

Voted to let the contract as reported by Stephen Steere.

Voted - that Mr. Fernald provide new pillars for the front of the library.

Mrs. Harold F. Jones reported the State Library Association would meet here Tuesday, May 22, 1951.

Voted - that Mrs. Jones be a Committee to make arrangements for a meeting place and serving of dinner for the State Library Association meeting, also she choose her committee.

Collector Mr. Harold F. Jones reported no letters sent. Mrs. Kay Moore was appointed to write a form letter telling of library work accomplished and planned and Mr. Jones to send out the letters.

Voted that the Treasurer interview other librarians in the town about amount of Town appropriation to be asked for. Amount to be left to the discretion of Treasurer.

Voted - Not to close the Library the first 2 weeks in May.

Mr. Moore reported 1755 volumes catalogued and filed in the new card catalogue cabinet.

Minutes read and approved.
