Nine members of the Board of Directors met at the library on Jan. 30, 1952, it being a special meeting called by the President, Mr. Knight.

Mrs. Howard Jones reported on the gift to Miss Cora Burlingame. A second-hand electric refrigerator in excellent condition at a cost of \$25.00 has been purchased and installed in Miss Burlingame's home. The President named Dr. Tynge and Mr. Jernold as a cemetery committee to interview the Barnes family, as they are heirs of the Jewkes family, to secure their permission and approval of restoration of stones of Henry and Irene Jewkes in the Nicholas Whison Cemetery.

Mr. Knight reported that Mr. Ernest Hopkins was willing to reduce contract by \$190 by not painting, papering and whitening of ceiling of the 1st floor of the Jewkes House. After discussion, it was felt the house would be more saleable if this interior work was done.

It was voted that the contract be completed as per original agreement. Mr. Knight will advise Mr. Hopkins to do this a little later in the season.

Taking the lot at \$1500, the house at \$3500 plus \$3166.32 (amount already spent on the moving) \$190 for painting, etc., we arrived at an asking price of \$9500.00. Voted that Mr. Charles White have exclusive selling rights until July 1st, 1952, at the asking price of \$9500.

Mrs. Jones reported gift of a used desk from Alfred Payette and that the Secretary had acknowledged same.

Letters of application for the position of Librarian were received from Mrs. Mary Bryant of Greenville and Mrs. Harriet Scott. Mrs. Scott was appointed Librarian, beginning February 1 for the remainder of the year until the Annual Meeting in May.
