The regular Quarterly meeting of the Greenville Public Library Association was held on August 18, 1952, 12 members present. The Secretary read the report of the last meeting.

The Treasurer reported \$530 in Operating account, \$2900.36, Building acct with \$26.25 dividend to be added - Savings acct \$1080.57
Total amount now in invested funds \$10,470.

Mr. Tom Hall, membership chairman reported total membership of 63.

Mr. Hall volunteered to clear brush in cemetery.

Voted to ask Mrs. Hall to Cemetery Committee.

Voted to pay any incidental expense in connection with setting up of gravestones.

Voted to authorize Board of Directors to proceed with sale of Jewkes House to Mr. George H. Parker Jr. at \$7500 - \$500 down, mortgage at 5% to be assumed by the Library Assn.

Voted to sell barn at \$125

Voted to recommend to Board of Directors to investigate possibility of various financial and architectural types of buildings for consideration within our financial capacity.
