Annual Mtg.

The Annual Meeting of the Greenville Public Library Assn was held on May 16. The meeting was called to order by the President, Dr. Tynge at 8. P.M. with 16 members present. The Secretary's report was read and accepted. The Treasurer reported a balance of \$ 973. 73 in Acct 880; Building Fund stands at \$ 3960.36 Operating Acct \$ 96. 92. This last figure existing only because of a loan of \$ 115 from Acct 880.

Suggested changes in By. Laws were read by the President, as prepared by committee consisting of Mrs. Esther Jones, K. K. Moore and Dr. Tynge. voted that the report on Constitution be accepted for ratification at the next meeting.

Book Committee Chairman, Mrs. Esther Jones reported 87 books received. Of the State Appropriation of \$ 232, half would be spent in the Dec, half in February. \$ 60 of this to be spent for juvenile and \$ 56 for adult. Our Library borrowed 35 Juvenile Books from the State Extension Service.

Mr. A. K. Moore reported on classifying the Library's collection. In addition to processing the new books for circulation, Mr. Moore has re-numbered and labelled the back wall book case this year. This report was accepted with appreciation.
