

This will provide new books during the summer when no State funds are available.

President Dr. Tynny presented the proposition of a new Library Building. He reported that a brick building 64 x 24 including plumbing and heating would be built for \$22,000. He suggested a new plan which would involve providing the necessary facilities for school rooms in the basement which would alleviate the crowded conditions in the Union School.

Mr. Moore reported shelving costs would be \$2281 for 1250 feet of shelving which would accommodate a collection of 10,000 volumes. After a great deal of discussion, it was voted to table the matter of building until such time as the fund reaches a figure which would enable us to build a more adequate and suitable building for the needs of the community.

The Treasurer was instructed to request \$500 Town Appropriation from the Budget Committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 10 P.M.
