The Secretary's report was read and accepted.

The Treasurer reported \$1595.22 in Oct. #2856; \$1010.35 in #880. He reported \$21,710 cash dispensed for investments. Balance in operating account \$35.47.

The report of the Book Committee was read and thanks extended to Mrs. Harold Jones, chairman and her committee. The sum of \$100 was voted to be used by the Book Committee for new books during the summer.

Mrs. Scott, Librarian, reported circulation for the year 5866 including 2748 juveniles ~~and~~ an increase of 859 over last year. Registered card holders now number 606 including 392 children.

Mrs. Kay K. Moore reported 443 books processed this last year. 179 new adults, 33 juvenile, a total of 312 new books, 76 being gifts from 7 known donors.
