As a measure for a fund for the educational activities of the Library during the coming year it was voted that each member contribute the sum of three dollars.

It was voted that the Annual Meeting of Association Members for the reading of reports and election of officers be adjourned from May 19 to the evening of May 20.

It was voted that the spending of a sum not exceeding \$250. be authorized for spraying the exterior of the building with one coat of silicon, the work to be done on a non-windy day.

Mrs Moore, chairman of the book committee, told of \$500.00 in books which had been made available by the recently organized Federal Library Service for Rural Areas, and said that books to that sum had been selected and ordered, many of them being basic reference books of which the library stands in great need. In as much as a second sum of \$500. will become available on July 1st, the shifting of these books presents a serious problem. This, the Book Committee suggests can be solved by building new shelves in the northeast corner of the present workroom, thus providing a Reference Alcove sufficient for immediate needs. Also, since the fiction-shelves in the Reading Room are already crowded, Mrs Moore suggested that the placing of shelves at the far wall in the East Hall would accommodate mystery and detective stories, thus relieving the congestion of the fiction shelves. Both projects were duly approved and authorized.

Mrs Moore spoke also of her personal custom of giving a memorial book to the library following the death of a friend, and suggested that others adopt this custom.
