Among the Association members present, at the Annual Meeting held on May 26th, were President and Mrs Moore, Mr and Mrs Andrew B. Winsor, Mr and Mrs Scott, Mrs. Jones, Dr. Tynng, Mr. Fernald, Mrs Dexter, Mrs Reid, and Miss Stillwell.

The Secretary's and Treasurer's reports were read and approved.

The Librarian reported 1400 registered borrowers, who during the year had taken out a total of 17,421 books, an increase of 5,200 over last year's circulation. Of these, 10,802 books were taken out by children (2,000 more than a year ago). During the present year, 952 books have been added, she said, including many reference and scientific books. Interestingly enough, the circulation shows adults to be interested in books on the useful arts, travel and fiction, while those taken out by children have largely been on science and biography. Mrs Dexter told of two booktalks which she had given at the William Winsor and the Pleasant View Avenue Schools; and in closing, thanked Mrs Baker, Mrs Calderara, Mrs Scott, Mrs Wright and other volunteer workers who had given her valued assistance.

Mrs Moore also gave a tribute to various volunteers - Miss Allan, Mrs Baker, Mrs Calderara, Mrs Cronhimer, Mrs Dexter, Mr. Fernald, Mr. Howard, Mrs Lopez, Mrs Scott, Miss Stillwell, Mrs Tattimer and Mrs Wright - each of whom had been especially helpful in book selection, library activities, or the cataloguing project.
