Annual
Meeting
June 16, 1960

The Annual Meeting of the Greenville Public Library was held on June 16, 1960 with a quorum present. The meeting was opened with the reading and acceptance of the Secretary's report of the year just past. The Treasurer's report was then read and accepted subject to the Auditor's approval.

It was announced by the President, Mr. Moore, that at a recent Town Meeting it was voted that the books of all departments allotted more than \$1,000.00 a year should be submitted for auditing; also, that the Library was allotted \$2,372.00 for the coming year.

Mr. Dexter, the Librarian, reported a gain of nearly 3,000 in circulation, and of 474 in the number of card holders or patrons. He gave a graphic description of his activities at the Library and also of his schedule in visiting various classes at Pleasant View School and in receiving classes at the Library from William Winsor School.

Mr. Fernald made the interesting suggestion that local men of scientific knowledge and experience be asked to assist during Science Week. He also suggested having a printed handbill
