Meeting  
Oct. 15, 1962

At the Executive meeting held on October 15, 1962, those present were the President and Mrs. Moore, Mr. Fernald, Mr. and Mrs. Winsor, Mrs. Lockwood, Mr. Ellingworth, and Miss Stillwell.

The report of the Secretary - presented at the Annual Meeting was read and accepted, as also was the Treasurer's report, which showed disbursements to date of \$1919.65 with a bank balance of \$703.36 and a payment of \$3372.00 due from the Town of Smithfield.

The President reported that the Greenville Public Library is one of seven Rhode Island libraries applying for the current Dorothy Canfield Fisher award. He also read a letter urging our Trustees to become members of the Rhode Island Library Association.

It was voted that Mr. Fernald should deputize Mr. Scott to have a layer of silicon rolled on the north wall on the outside of the Library building.

The sum of \$900.00 was authorized for the purchase of a charging desk to harmonize in color, finish, and design with the Librarian's desk already installed.

It was voted that a reconditioned typewriter be purchased and Mr. Winsor volunteered to procure one from the agency that supplied one for the Greenville Baptist Church.

It was re-voted that adjustable storm-windows and screens be installed in the west windows of the Main Room and Mr. Fernald was asked to give the matter his attention.

Miss Stillwell as chairman of the Activities Committee announced plans for inviting the school Principals of Smithfield to a Panel Discussion of ways for increasing school and library co-operation, the Panel to be held in recognition of Children's Book
