A meeting of the Executive Committee of the Greenville Public Library, was held Feb. 25, 1965, at 8:00 P.M. at the library, with the following members present: Mrs. Cronkover, Mr. Mungworth, Mr. Moore, Miss Stillwell, and Mr. and Mrs. Winsor.

Mr. Winsor reported that \$25,620.70 had been received to date for the building drive with more pledged. Mr. Moore reported that the Rhode Island Foundation had evinced interest in our application for funds and had requested six copies of everything we had sent in, to provide copies for each of its trustees. Miss Stillwell reported that two foundations, the Carl Pforzheimer and Collier Foundations, had sent letters of regret that they could not respond to our request for funds.

It was voted that the architect's fees to date be paid from our operating account, since this expenditure could not be used to match the state aid grant for construction.

Mr. Winsor reported the following figures on our operating funds to date: Income \$15,038.55; Expenditures \$10,193.40; Balance \$4,845.15. Savings account #880 has a balance of \$7,063.97 and savings account #2856 has a balance of \$3,517.50.

It was noted that the recent death of Charles A. Scott, Jr., had left the position of Assistant Treasurer vacant at the present time. It was moved, seconded, and voted unanimously that Robert E. Straight be named Assistant Treasurer, to fulfill the Treasurer's duties in the event that the regular Treasurer, Andrew B. Winsor, should not be able to act, with authority to handle the checking and savings accounts in the Greenville branch of the Citizens' Bank.

The proposed budget request to the Town of Smithfield, totalling \$11,682, was gone over item by item; it was moved, seconded, and voted that Mr. Winsor fill out the necessary forms for such a request. Mr. Winsor and Mr. Moore were authorized to represent the Board at a hearing before the Town Council acting on the
