For the Building Committee and Planning Board, the past year has been a busy one, as it has for its two sub-committees - the Fund Raising Drive headed by Mr. Mlingworth and the Publicity Committee headed by Mrs. Moore. The passing of the Library Services and Construction Act sponsored by Congressman John E. Fogarty of Rhode Island, and signed by President Johnson on Feb. 11, 1964, and the recommendations of the Rhode Island State Legislative Commission on Libraries developed under the chairmanship of Mr. X. X. Moore, and passed by the Rhode Island Legislature early this year, have made legally possible the securing of matching funds from Governmental sources, needed for the addition of our proposed Young Peoples Wing.
