Mr. Dexter. The circulation of air in the furnace room has been improved, and a fire-resistant container for rubbish installed. Also two metal rubbish cans have been placed in front of the building, in the hope of preventing the litter caused by the bales of newspapers that are dumped there daily by the Providence Journal and Evening Bulletin. A safety chain has been installed on the front doors. And the handrail at the exit to the parking area has been re-enforced and set on a wooden molding, as the rail has twice been pulled out from its mooring on the cement wall, by children, who continually use it as a vaulting pole as they run down stairs to the exit. This dependence on the rail by elderly persons has become a hazard.
