

Sept. 23, 1965

A meeting of the Greenville Library Association was held at the library Sept. 23, 1965, at 8 o'clock with the following persons in attendance: Mr. and Mrs. Moore, Mr. and Mrs. Kenner, Miss Stillwell, Mrs. Lockwood, Mrs. Dexter, Mr. Gallagher, Mr. Mengworth, Miss Connor, Mr. Rigney, Mr. Straight, Mr. Butler and Mrs. Wright.

The Secretary's report was read and accepted as was the Treasurer's.

Mr. Dexter reported that the cataloging was done now and that at the moment business was a little slow but would soon gain momentum as the school year got underway. The Librarian's report was accepted.

Miss Stillwell gave the report on the progress of the Building Committee. Excavation for the new wing was started on August 9th, 1965, and the entire project should be completed within 240 days. The report was accepted as read and placed on file.

Mr. Mengworth spoke concerning the Building Fund Drive which has been dormant during the summer months. However, he, Mr. and Mrs. Moore, and Miss Stillwell had met with Mr. Austin to go over maps of the town for a house to house drive to be launched around Nov. 1st. About \$5,000.00 more is needed to put the drive over the top. Miss Stillwell suggested that the school children might be taken on a tour of the building when it is really in shape and perhaps be asked to contribute some money which they had earned.

Mr. Moore announced that the Northern Regional Library Meeting would be held at the library Tuesday, Sept. 28th, from 10 A.M. to 12 noon. Fourteen libraries were invited to attend.

The letter concerning the membership drive was to be written and an item concerning the Building Fund added to it. Mrs. Moore suggested that we have a Business Men's Coffee Hour some time during the winter months ahead.

Mr. Moore spoke regarding the standards set up by the Department of State Libraries. Some of the standards are now enforced at Greenville Public Library, but all must be within five years. For instance, at present, we have -
