(Continued) Erection of the Children's Wing testified to its success. Miss Stielwell read the Building Committee report and remarked that this year they had spent over \$100,000.00. A full report on the Building Committee follows this entry.

Mrs. Lockwood gave the report of the Furnishings Committee and announced that all had been ordered, except a vacuum cleaner, a necessary expenditure, as the rug in the Children's room was down.

Mrs. Moore reported that the Activities Committee had been too busy with the Building Committee to have a report of its own.

The Membership Committee reported there were about 115 paid memberships. Mr. Moore gave a brief report on the Smithfield Library Council, explaining that the State Aid Grants given to the Town of Smithfield were divided by the three libraries, with Greenville receiving half and Bernon and Comond, one fourth each. The Department of State Library Services allotted the money on a population basis. He went into detail on the standards that have been set up and how we are meeting them.

Next on the agenda was New Business and the all important question of "When do we move into the new building?" It was decided that the library would be closed from the 13th of June to the 20th of June, while this was accomplished. All fines were to be relaxed.

A letter from Miss Fooks of the Providence Public Library was read, asking us to participate in a program which would bring Richard Chase to Greenville to speak in September. It was decided that we should not participate in this at present.
