

At a special meeting of the Board of Directors of the Greenville Public Library held at the library room Monday evening June 27, 1887 Daniel F. Chandler was elected Secretary pro-tem. It was voted that D. F. Chandler be a committee to notify Mr. O. Tobey that the Library Association wished to take possession of the back room of the Library Building on or before the first of August.

The president and Mr. Murray were appointed a committee to confer with Miss Josephine E. Thiers, the owner of the building in regard to fitting up the back room and doing other repairs on the building. The sum to be laid out to be such an amount as would bring the whole amount upon which the Library Association pay interest to one thousand dollars.

D. S. Chandler and Rev. W. S. Latham were elected a committee on Catalogue,
