

Article 7.

The Librarian and Assistant Librarians shall have the custody of all the books, pamphlets, documents and other movable property of the Association pertaining to the Library and Reading Room; they shall keep such record as the Executive Committee may require.

Article 8.

The Property Committee shall consist of three members appointed by the President from the Trustees. This committee shall have custody of all physical property of the Association.

Article 9.

The Chairman of the Membership Committee shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Association, said Chairman to select his own committee. The duties of this committee shall be to solicit new members and to render bills to members on record within 30 days after the annual meeting.

Article 10.

The Chairman of the Book Committee shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Association and shall select an additional three members, the Librarian and Assistant Librarians being members ex-officio. The duties of this committee shall be to select and purchase books with funds available, to purchase supplies as the budget permits, and to make use of the extension service of the R. I. State Library.

Article 11.

The use of the Library shall be free to all residents of the Town of Smithfield, subject to such rules and regulations as may be established by the Executive Committee. Non-residents may be admitted to the use of the Library upon such conditions as the Executive Committee may determine.

Article 12.

These By-Laws may be altered or amended by a vote of two-thirds of the members present at any regular meeting of the Association; provided such alteration or amendment has been proposed at a previous regular meeting.

Article 13.

Roberts' Rules of Order shall govern all proceedings of this Association.
